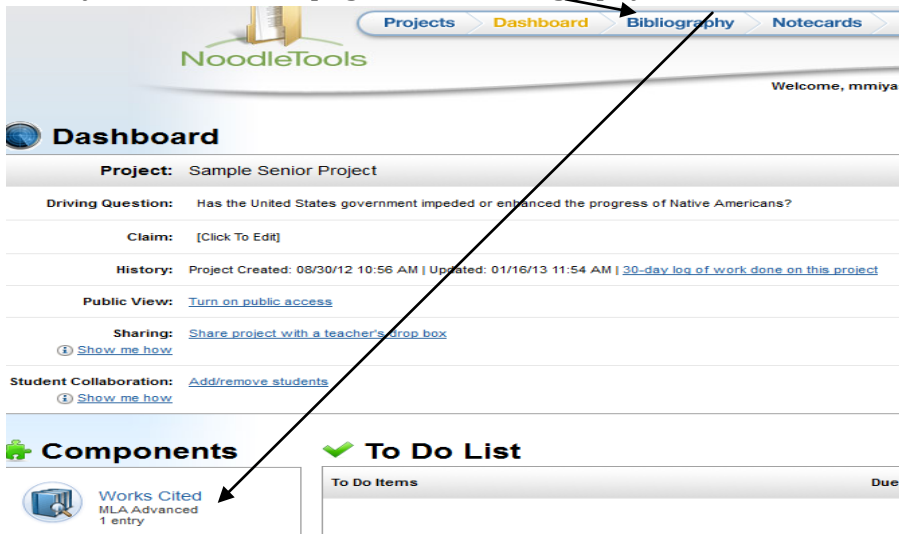
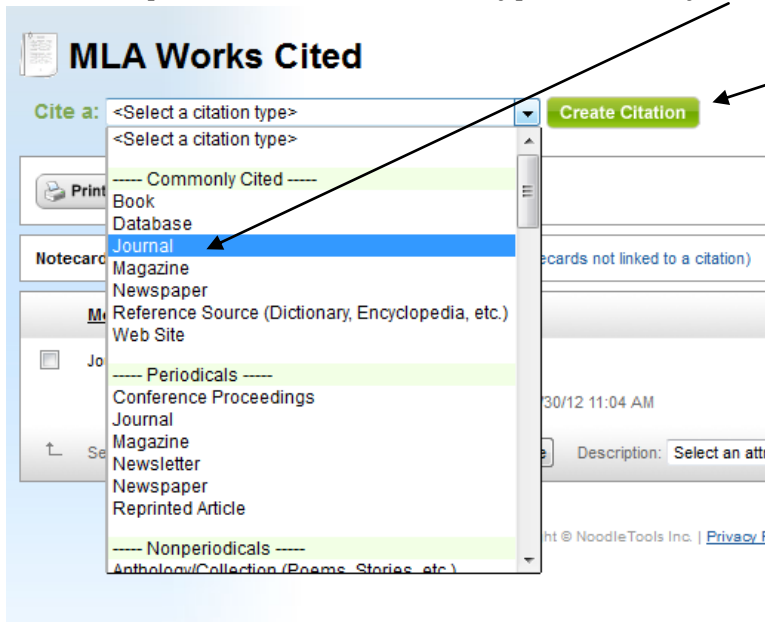


# Noodle Tools: Creating a Source Citation

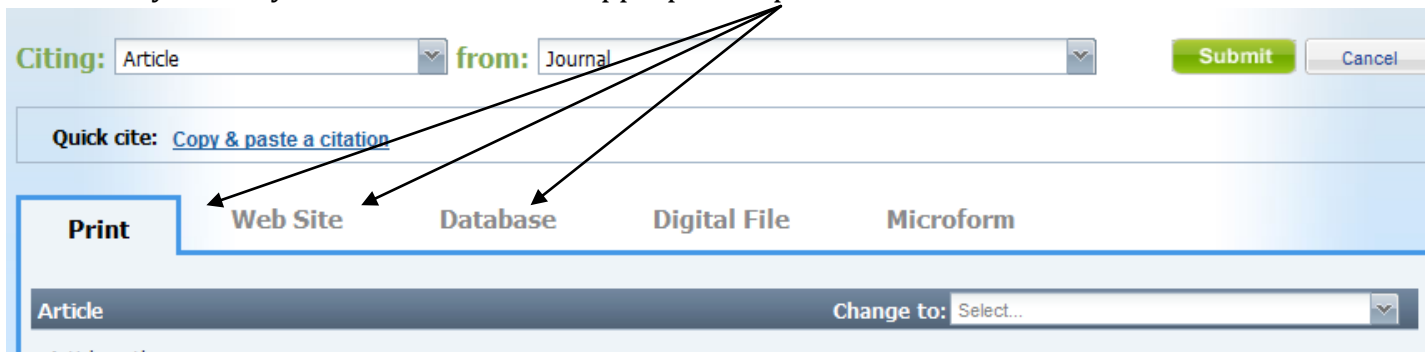
1. From your Dashboard page, click “Bibliography” or “Works Cited”



2. On the drop-down menu, select the type of source you are citing. Then click “Create Citation.”



3. Click the green “Continue” on the next page.
4. Where did you find your source? Click the appropriate option:




5. Fill in the boxes with the information from your source. If you have questions or cannot find the


information on your source, please raise your hand for a teacher to help you. Click “Submit” to create your citation.
