

Finding Periodical Articles for JP

(What is a periodical article? An article from a magazine OR newspaper.)

Option 1

Use a database.

Start at the Library's website

<https://sites.google.com/a/nlcphs.net/nlcplibrary/home>

On the right-hand side, click on Chicago Public School Databases.

Try *Student Resources in Context* (it has the most articles), *Opposing Viewpoints in Context* and *FirstSearch*.
