

What if I forget my password?

Click on “I forgot my password.”

Already Have a Personal ID?

I got my password hint, but I still can't figure out my password. What should I do?

Email Ms. Gruber, lgruber@nlcphs.org. She can reset your password. She typically responds to emails within 24 hours.

I can't remember my Personal ID. Should I create a new account?

No! Don't create a new account. Having multiple accounts can create a lot of confusion down the road. Email Ms. Gruber, lgruber@nlcphs.org. She can look up your Personal ID and reset your password.

My notecards got deleted! What's happening?

Don't worry. This has never actually happened. If you can't find your notecards, there are two possibilities.

- 1) You have multiple Noodletools accounts, and you've logged into an old account. Email Ms. Gruber, lgruber@nlcphs.org, and she can clear up the confusion.
- 2) On the Notecard Tabletop, click on the icon that looks like a recycling bin. If you've accidentally deleted notecards, you can undelete them.
